Welcome to VRCC Oncology! We have 2 branches to our Oncology department, Medical Oncology and Radiation Oncology, that are available for you, your clients, and your patients.

Our goals as a team are to provide the best patient (and pet owner) care with the upmost compassion, while providing as much quality time for our patients and families together, as possible.

Medical Oncology:

Our medical oncologists see a variety of different cases from bladder cancers to sarcomas - and everything in between. We currently have 2 medical oncologists available Mondays-Fridays to help with your clients and patients.

Dr. Robyn Elmslie founded the VRCC Oncology department in 1993, intending to combine her clinical oncology expertise with her immunology research. Dr. Elmslie's main goal for her patients has always been keeping their quality of life as the driving factor on their journey through cancer diagnosis and treatment.

Radiation Oncology:

We are very excited to introduce our new radiation oncologist Dr. Greg Vernon! Dr. Vernon enjoys using radiation to treat a large variety of tumor types with radiation, with particular interest in nasal tumors and brain tumors.

Here is a list of tumors that we can see for potential radiation therapy. This list is by no means exhaustive, and if you have a case where you are unsure if radiation may help, feel free to contact Dr. Vernon for a quick chat.

- 1. Nasal tumors (nasal carcinoma, sarcoma, lymphoma)
- 2. Brain tumors (meningioma, glioma, choroid plexus tumors)
- 3. Soft tissue sarcoma in microscopic disease setting
 - i.e. previous surgery with no gross disease but 'dirty' margins
- 4. Oral tumors (squamous cell carcinoma, melanoma, fibrosarcoma, acanthomatous ameloblastoma)
- 5. Osteosarcoma (IF they are specifically interested in radiation therapy)
 - i.e. owners are opposed to amputation or poor amputation candidate
- 6. Thyroid carcinoma
- 7. Apocrine gland anal sac adenocarcinoma (AGASACA)

If poor candidate for surgery, or if surgical option is unknown.
